Include at least one dashing outfit for this special occasion. Choose something extraordinary to mark this once-in-a-lifetime event! My favorite is a suit with no tie.

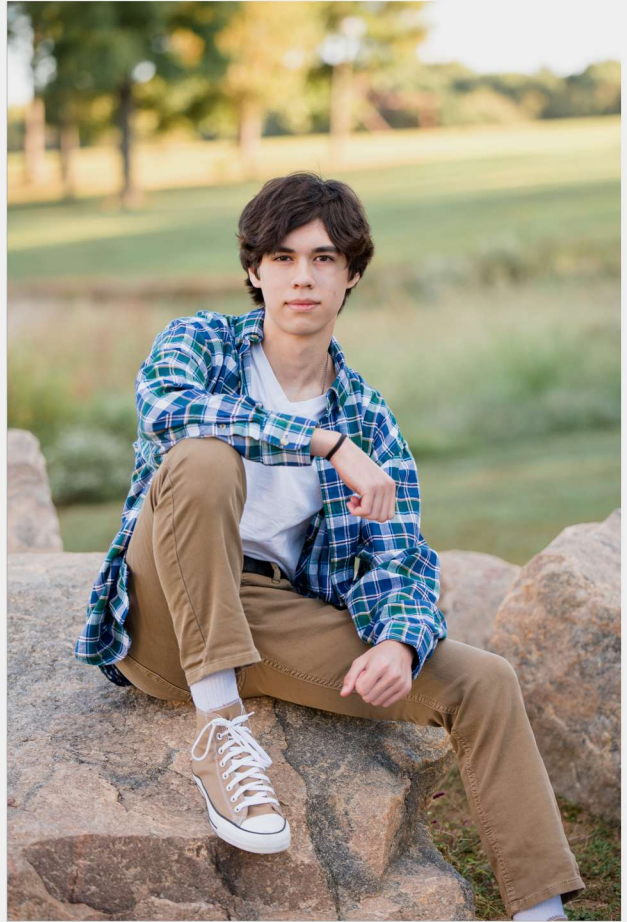

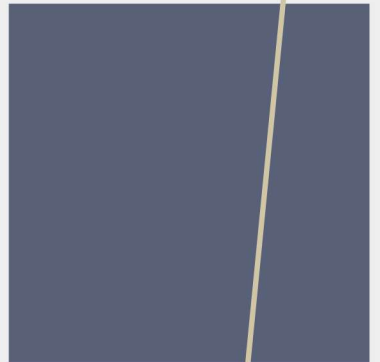
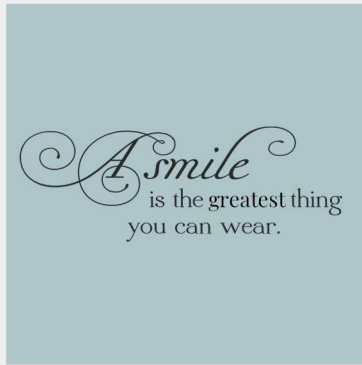
Senior Portraits can showcase your unique personality and passions. Add spark to your photos by including pastimes, musical instruments, sports, and even family pets!

DETAILS FOR YOUR SHOOT...



> Unless you have facial hair, come to your session smooth, shaving just a few hours before your session.

> If you get a haircut for your session, be sure to do it at least 2 weeks ahead of time.

> Stay away from busy patterns, especially tiny pinstripes as they can cause the photos to look fuzzy.

> Pay attention to your socks and shoes! They will show in full-length shots.

> Feel free to accessorize with hats, sunglasses, jackets, or boots

> Make sure your clothes fit you well and are not too baggy.

> Don't forget the belt if your outfit calls for one!
